Royal Gourock Yacht Club Corporate Sailing Days are just that little bit different. Each event is built around a series of short yacht races in the club's fleet of Piper yachts. These yachts take 3-4 people, are safe and stable, are ideal for beginners, yet can provide a real challenge for experienced crews. Using a range of sail sizes we configure the boats to suit your requirements and the weather conditions of the day.

At one extreme where your people are complete novices we restrict the yachts to simple, reduced power sails. The boat is helmed and managed by one of our expert helmsman, but your crew do all the work of setting and tuning the sails under instruction, in a real race environment. They rapidly find that they have to divide resources and co-operate in performing a range of co-ordinated tasks to make the yacht perform.



In no time at all an extremely competitive situation develops as all sorts of rivalries develop between the teams. Over the day each crew of three will sail in a number of different yachts with different helmsmen. As skills develop so does the competitiveness and enjoyment. At the end of day a prize giving is held for the most successful crews.



At the other extreme, you or your clients, can provide their own competent yacht crews. In this situation we do not provide a helmsman and equip the yachts with a full set of racing sails. The yachts are simple so that even these who have never been in a Piper will rapidly fit in. If you are in doubt we can send along a caretaker to help you out.

But being out on the water racing is not the full experience. You have full use of the beautiful club building and its facilities. A large balcony where these crews on rota ashore get a grandstand view.
