

THE CLUBHOUSE

During last year visible changes have taken place around the Clubhouse and thanks to a small team of very dedicated Members these are ongoing, as they continue to repair, re-new and alter the upstairs Lounge and rooms within, what was, the Flat. The latter will be used to provide a small lounge with a television, staff accommodation and storage facilities.

The barrier-free toilet and entrance ramp are now in place, funded by an 'Awards for All' Grant. A very smart Function Suite has been created, by removing the wall between the Dining and Cadet Rooms and there is also a new bin storage area – to visibly shield the bins.

Head Chef, Patrick Mealey has been joined by Nicole Harron, as Assistant Chef. with Stewart Campbell as Sous Chef. Bar Management/Front of House is in the capable hands of Eileen McKelvie and there are some new faces among the Bar Staff. Each is compliant with the new Licensing Laws and have the appropriate certificates.

The Clubhouse is for use by Members and their guests, for a variety of occasions, parties, christenings, weddings and meetings, where catering can be organized to suit your particular needs.

The Premises Licence has now been received – this sets out what we can and cannot do. Stricter policing is now in force, which means that Members must ensure to properly 'sign in' all their guests, as both Police Officers and Licensing Service Officers may enter and inspect the register at any time.

Application for Membership no longer requires to be Proposed and Seconded, this change was necessary in order to obtain the 'Awards for All Grant'. However, applicants names are still posted on the Notice Board and anyone having doubts as to the suitability of any Applicant, should inform any of the Flag Officers, or myself, before the monthly Meeting takes place.

The Club currently has 475 Members - 106 Inport, 10 Midport, 82 Outport, 69 Spouse, 55 Retired, 147 House and 4 Honorary.

The Club values all its Members, especially those who put their time and effort into maintaining and improving our interests.

It is essential for the future of this Club and also for the Sport of Sailing that more is done to encourage young Sailing Members to join. It would be good to think that this Club will still be promoting the sport of sailing to future generations and the Clubhouse will still be providing social activities for all.
