

CADET SECTION

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The objects of the Cadet Section are the encouragement and training of Cadets in Yacht Sailing and racing and repairing them to accept their responsibilities as future Club Members.

With these aims in view the following notes are for the guidance of Cadets and their parent or guardian on the privileges and limitations of Cadets in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Club.

1.5 CADET RULES (Extracted from the Cadet Manual)

1.5.1 The Cadet Rules are set out below.

- 1 Cadets shall be over the age of twelve and under the age of eighteen years on the date of admission.
- 2 Cadets are admitted for one year only and may be re-admitted annually. After attaining the age of eighteen, Cadets require to apply as Members of the Club and are subject to the usual admission procedure.
- 3 Cadets shall pay such Annual Subscription as may be fixed from time to time by the Committee, which shall entitle them to sail in the Club Boats without further payment. (Subject to responsible person being present)
- 4 Cadets shall not take or bring drugs or alcohol of any kind onto the premises.
- 5 Cadets may only introduce one visitor at anyone time to the Clubhouse and are responsible for ensuring their visitor complies with the Rules. More than one visitor must be authorised in advance by a Committee Member.
- 6 Cadets will have the privilege of using the Cadet Room or such other area as may be authorised during the hours stipulated by the Committee.
- 7 Cadet shall not conduct themselves in the Club premises as to cause annoyance to the members of the staff, and must obey the instructions of the Clubhouse staff when on the Club premises.
- 8 Cadets are responsible for the tidiness of the Cadet Room and for returning to the Bar empty bottles and glasses and for putting into the baskets provided, waste paper and other rubbish arising from their use of the Club.
- 9 Cadet training afloat and ashore will be arranged on Thursday evenings from 18:30 and at other times at the discretion of the Committee.
- 10 Cadets will accept the Instructor's / Club Boatman's advice on sailing conditions at all times and will assist the Boatman when requested.

1.5.2 Each Cadet must provide a suitable life jacket / buoyancy aid and adequate waterproof clothing.

1.5.3 Lifejackets / Buoyancy Aids must be worn at all times when taking part in water based activities or awaiting the launch at the slip.

1.5.4 The Cadet Committee reserves the right to suspend any Cadet who brings the Cadet Section or the Club into disrepute.
